## **2021 Missouri Mayflower Society Scholarship Requirements**

**The Missouri Mayflower Society Scholarship Contest is open to any high school senior who is a resident of the State of Missouri and a Citizen of the United States, and who is planning to attend an institution of higher learning in the fall of 2021. For 2021, three scholarship awards are being offered, in the amount of \$1,500 for 1<sup>st</sup> place, \$1000 for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and \$500 for 3<sup>rd</sup> place. The scholarships will be payable to the students' accounts at the colleges or universities in which they have enrolled.**

Mayflower descent is not a requirement, but may be considered along with other qualifications.

No photograph is to be submitted with the application.

### **Required Application Attachments:**

- 1) Proof of US Citizenship: attach a photocopy of birth certificate or passport. If a copy of passport is used, photograph should be blocked out.
- 2) An essay of no more than 750 words on the topic **“Explore the Relationship between Massasoit and the *Mayflower* Passengers.”**
- 3) A bibliography listing reference sources utilized for the essay, including any Internet resources along with their electronic addresses. The Missouri Society website at [www.momayflower.org](http://www.momayflower.org) has links to websites with excellent information about the Pilgrims. Books and encyclopedias should also be utilized.
- 4) A one or two page statement explaining your goals and listing interests, activities, honors or awards, employment and/or community service.
- 5) Two letters of recommendation, one of which may be from a teacher or counselor, and one from a family friend, church or scout leader, etc.
- 6) A copy of high school transcript including GPA and SAT and/or ACT scores.

**The Scholarship Application must be mailed and postmarked by March 1, 2021.**
